Reading and Phonics

We will continue learning the Little Wandle Phase 4 Phonics -

- Long vowel sounds – cvcc, ccvc, cccvc, ccv, ccvcc.
- Words ending s, es, ing, ed, er, est
- Longer words
- Review all Tricky Words.

We will look at the Jigsaw unit of **Changing Me**. This includes getting ready for the next school year by expressing how they feel about changes, looking forward to what's coming next, as well as celebrating previous successes.

We will be making the most of being outside to practise for Sports Day.

Maths

The children will continue to follow the 'Master the Curriculum scheme' – looking at:

- Visualising, mapping and building
- Making connections – within numbers and patterns

Literacy

We will be reading lots of Traditional Tales. The children will have opportunities to retell the stories using different voices and include the repeated language. We will be continuing our Drawing Club journey using the Traditional Tales as a stimulus for writing. The children will be encouraged to write independently and apply their phonic knowledge as well as spell some Tricky Words.

Understanding the World

We will be looking at changes from Spring to Summer.

The children will be learning about seeds and how they grow. We will be planting some seeds.

We will be investigating floating and sinking.

We will be looking at objects from the past and comparing them with everyday objects that we use today.

R.E.

We will be looking at how do people know how to treat each other.

Understanding Christianity – why is the word God so important to Christians?

Expressive Arts & Design

We will continue to safely use and explore a variety of materials. We will be making props linked to our Traditional Tales including an apron, a bridge, a chair and a shoe.

The children will be encouraged to talk about their creations, explaining the processes they have used.

We will also be using musical instruments to accompany songs. We will follow the Charanga music unit - Reflect, Rewind and Replay
