

Reading and Phonics

In Phonics we will be continuing to follow the Little Wandle programme by taking part in daily sessions including games of 'What's in the box' with focus on the following letter sounds:

s,a,t,p,i,n

We will also be exploring voice sounds and the different sounds we can make using our voices.

PSED

The children will be learning to safely explore emotions beyond their normal range through play and stories.

We will be continuing to follow our Jigsaw protective behaviours scheme with focus on Celebrating Difference. We will be talking about what we are good at and what makes us special.

We will also be discussing our families and lives at home.

R.E.

In R.E our focus this term is Incarnation.

We will be exploring why Christians perform nativity plays and celebrate at Christmas through Christmas stories and nativity sets. We will also be recapping our knowledge of Christian, Muslim and Hindu world views and how people belong together.

Maths

In Maths we will be recapping our knowledge from last term of sorting and matching objects.

We will also be looking at Numbers 1 and 2 through numeral matching, counting and subitising. The children will be exploring and matching simple patterns, learning how to recognise, create and extend them.

Literacy

This term we will be focusing on traditional tales such as Goldilocks and The Three Bears and Jack and the Beanstalk to encourage the children to engage in extended conversations about stories and join in with repeated refrains. The children will also be using the texts to anticipate key events and phrases in stories and will be using their knowledge and recollection skills to retell and recreate them through sequencing and acting out.

In mark-making we will be continuing to give meaning to our marks when creating pictures.

Understanding the World

We will continue to focus on the Autumnal season and explore the changes to objects in our environment as the seasons change. As part of this exploration, we will be examining both natural and man- made objects, exploring how some things grow naturally.

We will also be looking in detail at a variety of celebrations this term including Diwali, Remembrance day and Christmas.



Expressive Arts & Design

The children will be exploring colours and colour mixing, discovering the different effects that can happen to a colour when it is mixed with a variety of different materials.

We will also be working on collaging by gluing and sticking with a variety of craft materials.

P.E.

We will be focusing on using our core strength through obstacle courses, scarf movement and ball skills.

We will also be having Cosmic Kids yoga sessions and exploring how our bodies can move in a variety of different ways.
