

Reading and Phonics

In Phonics we will continue to follow the Little Wandle Phonics scheme and will be oral blending and taking part in oral blending games with focus on the following letter sounds:

e,u,r,h,b

PSED

In PSED we will continue to follow our Jigsaw protective behaviours scheme where our focus this term is 'Healthy me'.

The children will be labelling familiar body parts and we will be learning about the importance of being healthy. We will be looking in detail at what it means to be healthy and the key elements to being healthy including healthy food, self-care, sleep and tooth brushing.

R.E.

Our R.E focus for this term is Palm Sunday. We will be looking in detail at the Easter story and discovering how different people celebrate Easter. We will also be exploring the concept of leadership- what makes a good leader and what is the importance of a leader making good choices.

Maths

In Maths we will be consolidating our knowledge of 1-5 and we will be continuing to follow our Mastering the curriculum scheme where we will be extending our numerical recognition, counting and subitising skills up to number 6.

We will also be exploring length, height ordering, capacity and weight ordering by using a variety of animal resources to order objects according to categories including their weight, height and capacity.

Literacy

In Literacy we will be learning to spot and suggest rhyme and rhythm in spoken words and we will also be learning to count and clap syllables in words.

We will be continuing to develop our pencil grips and will be using our pencil grips to mark make in a variety of ways including mark-making in anti- clockwise movements

Understanding the World

We will be using our animal's theme to explore a variety of different animals, their characteristics and how we can identify and distinguish between their features and the differences in their habitats. The children will also be taking part in vets/pets to role-play to explore and understand the needs of animals and the importance of taking care of them.



Expressive Arts & Design

We will be continuing to construct with a purpose and will be learning to verbalise our intentions prior to constructing. The children will be learning to draw with increasing complexity and to create closed shapes using continuous lines. We will also be experimenting with a wide range of materials when creating.

P.E.

In PE we will be continuing to build on our core strength through various large muscles movements and exercises.

We will be taking part in a broad range of team games involving a variety of equipment including beanbags, balls and hoops.

We will also be continuing with our cosmic kid's yoga sessions to further develop our core strength.
