

Reading and Phonics

In Phonics we will continue to be following our Little Wandle Programme with Name play, Bertha the Bus and Blend from the box sessions with focus on the following letter sounds:

f,l,j,v,w,y,z

We will be continuing to follow our Jigsaw PSHE scheme where our focus this term is relationships. We will be talking about friendships, what makes a friendship special and how we can be a good friend and kind to others. The children will also be exploring how we can work together with others and the importance of recognising and responding to our own feelings and the feelings of others.

During our RE sessions this term the children will be learning about how people know how to treat each other. We will be looking at the importance of values and exploring our schools' values and learning behaviours and why they are important.

Maths

In maths, the children will be developing their understanding of sequencing by ordering simple events using language such as first, next and last.

They will also be exploring prepositions and learning to use positional language such as in, on, under and behind using minibeast props.

We will also be recapping our knowledge of 2D shapes and beginning to explore simple 3D shapes.

Literacy

The children will be learning about the 5 key concepts about print this term- Print has meaning, Print can have different purposes, print is read from left to right and top to bottom, the names of different parts of a book and page sequencing.

We will also be mark-making in a variety of ways including top to bottom, left to right and anti-clockwise and continuing with our learning of letter sounds.

We will be continuing to encourage the children to use the correct pencil grip when mark making.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about the lifecycles of different plants and animals including caterpillars, bees and sunflowers.

We will be learning about the importance of caring for our environment and what different aspects of our environment need in order for them to grow and planting in our garden to learn how to care for and grow things in our own environment.

Expressive Arts & Design

The children will be continuing to learn how to handle creative tools and equipment safely when creating.

We will also be learning to draw with complexity and colour and how to decision make when creating.

The children will also be using a wide variety of junk modelling and creative resources to encourage them to make decisions when creating.

P.E.

In our P.E sessions we will be taking part in a variety of team games to encourage working together as part of a team.

We will also be consolidating our physical skills when moving freely in a variety of ways and continuing to work on our core strength.
