- Sculptures can be created using many different types of materials such as: cardboard, plastic, concrete, food, Ice, wood, clay

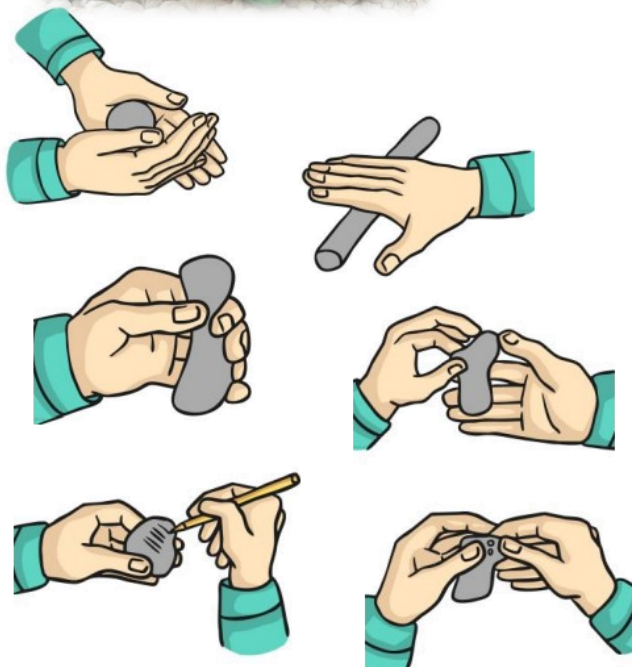
