Key Knowledge

- Columbus was an Italian explorer who was born in Genoa in 1451 and died in 1506.

He learnt to sail in a wooden ship with sails, using the sun, stars and a compass. His first trip at sea was when he was 13 years old and his dream was to go to China but he actually discovered a 'New World' (Americas).

- Columbus had three ships and sailed in the Santa Maria with the Pinta and Nina which were part of the fleet. He brought back many new things such as gold, silver and potatoes.

-There are 7 continents: **Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Australia.**

There are 5 oceans: **Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Arctic, Southern.**

Key Vocabulary

Voyage– A long journey where you travel by sea or space.

Christopher Columbus- was an Italian explorer who completed four voyages across the Atlantic ocean.

Explorer– A person who finds new or unfamiliar things.

Navigate- plan and direct the course of a ship using maps.

Pinta– One of the 3 ships used to help discover the 'new world'

Nina– One of the 3 ships to help discover the 'new world.'

Santa Maria– One of the 3 ships used to discover the 'new world'

Continents-A large solid area of land. Most continents are made up of a group of countries.

Ocean: A large body of salt water.

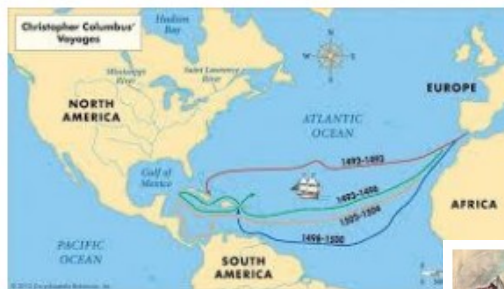
